


## **Discussion Highlights:**

- 1. Types of Cooperatives in the Philippines
  - Overview of various cooperatives operating under Philippine law, emphasizing their roles in economic and social development.
  - The importance of cooperatives in empowering communities and supporting members' financial needs.
- 2. Overseas Filipino Savings, Loan, and Cooperative Concept
  - Presentation of a concept for establishing a cooperative specifically catering to Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) and Filipinos overseas.
  - Discussion on the potential for such a cooperative to support savings, loans, and remittance services tailored to the unique needs of OFWs and their families.

## **Background:**

- Over 10.2 million Filipinos live overseas, with approximately 2.16 million classified as OFWs in 2023.
- Majority are women (55.6%), with significant age groups between 30-45 years.
- OFWs engage primarily in elementary occupations, service, sales, and technical roles.
- CALABARZON region has the highest OFW population; Asia is the top destination, with Saudi Arabia and UAE leading.
- Total remittances reached PhP 238.63 billion in 2023, with banks handling 62.2% of cash remittances.

### **Prospects:**

- High volume of remittances presents an opportunity for cooperative-led financial services.
- OFWSLAC can provide targeted savings, loan, remittance, and advisory services to OFWs and their families.

#### Membership:

- Open to OFWs, Filipino migrants, dual citizens overseas, and their immediate families (with endorsement).
- Members may continue participation upon returning to the Philippines.

#### **Governance:**

- Board of Directors composed of **25 members** serving staggered terms (initial terms: 6 and 4 years). Filipino and dual Citizen is welcome.
- Elections are held every two years thereafter.
- Appointment of General Manager and committee members as per Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) guidelines.

#### **Services Offered:**

- Remittance services via authorized licensed partners.
- Automatic digital savings linked to remittance (2-10% deduction for fees).
- Digital loan services with low interest rates (1-2% per month), max loan up to 80% of savings.
- One-stop-shop assistance including government facilitation SSS, Pagibig etc payment shop) livelihood advisory, social/legal services, job opportunities, and training.

#### Actionable Items:

- Further feasibility study, Overseas Filipino association and groups and partners and stakeholder consultations for OFWSLAC establishment.
- Development of operational guidelines and partnership frameworks.
- Explore potential pilot programs to test remittance and digital savings services (Singapore based company)
